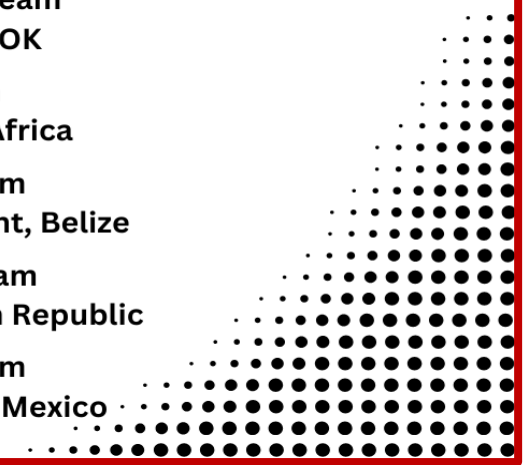

What: Medical, Dental, Educational & Evangelism

Medical Mission



Purpose of the Mission Trip

Medical: Through local partnerships with an established clinic, we will be offering basic medical services i.e. pain medications, examinations and external treatments of common afflictions

Dental: dental health screening, extracting teeth and localized pain medications

Education: interacting with grade school educators and students

Evangelism: includes witnessing the Gospel of Jesus Christ, and outreach crusades

Travel Requirements

Passport: A valid passport is **required** for this trip. Please ensure your passport does not expire within six (6) months of the travel dates.

Health and Safety

Immunizations and Health Concerns

There are no immunizations required for entry into Kenya; however, there are some that are highly recommended. The final decision is up to you. We suggest you speak with your personal physician or call the Center for Disease Control at 404-332-4559. You may visit their website at www.cdc.gov. Choose the Traveler's Health menu. We also suggest that you shop around for prices on the different immunizations. You will find that some clinics offer a lower cost than others or you might need to visit several different clinics to get the best prices per immunization.

The following is a list of recommended immunizations and medications:

- Yellow Fever -- A viral disease transmitted to humans by a mosquito bite. Upon receiving this vaccination, you will be given a yellow-signed certificate that you must keep on you during your visit to Kenya. Outbreaks of yellow fever have occurred in Ethiopia and Kenya. If you do not have this proof of vaccination with you on return and there has been an outbreak, they will not allow you return to the US until the outbreak is over.
- Malaria -- There is some risk throughout the year in the whole country, except there is generally no risk in Nairobi and areas above 2,500 meters such as the following provinces: Central, Eastern, Nyanza, Rift Valley and Western. The malaria pills can be acquired with a prescription from your physician. You will begin taking them two weeks prior to departure and continue taking one a week while in the risk areas plus, most importantly, continue taking them for four weeks after returning to the US. Many people tolerate malaria pills with few side effects. Mild nausea, abdominal cramps, headaches, insomnia and strange dreams can occur but tend to be self-limiting and tolerable.
- Hepatitis A -- Series of 2 injections.
- Hepatitis B -- Advised for persons staying in rural areas, or having intimate contact with the local population. Series of 3 injections.
- Polio -- A one-time booster is recommended for people who have previously completed a standard course of polio immunization.
- Typhoid -- Vaccination should be considered for persons venturing off the usual tourist routes into small cities, villages and rural areas.
- Meningitis -- May be acquired through people coughing, mouth-to-mouth, or indirect contact by touching an object recently contaminated with an infected person's nasal secretions.
- Tetanus -- May be contracted through any open wound.

History

The first people to develop Belize were the Maya around 1500 B.C.E. As shown in archeological records, they established a number of settlements here. These include Caracol, Lamanai and Lubaantun. The first European contact with Belize occurred in 1502 when Christopher Columbus reached the area's coast. In 1638, the first European settlement was established by England and for 150 years, many more English settlements were set up.

In 1840, Belize became a "Colony of British Honduras" and in 1862, it became a crown colony. For one hundred years after that, Belize was a representative government of England but in January 1964, full self-government with a ministerial system was granted. In 1973, the region's name was changed from British Honduras to Belize and on September 21, 1981, full independence was achieved.

Purpose of the Mission Trip

Evangelism: Street Evangelism in the streets of Prague, Czech Republic, singing & witnessing the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

Travel Requirements

Health and Safety

While immunization shots are not required, they are recommended for the safety and wellbeing of all participants.

History

Prague is the capital and largest city of the Czech Republic and the historical capital of Bohemia. Situated on the Vltava river, Prague is home to about 1.4 million people.

Prague is classified as an "Alpha-" global city. In 2019, the PICS Index ranked the city as the 13th most livable city in the world. Its rich history makes it a popular tourist destination and as of 2017, the city receives more than 8.5 million international visitors annually. In 2017, Prague was listed as the fifth most visited European city after London, Paris, Rome, and Istanbul.

Atheism and Agnosticism

Around 34.5% of the Czech Republic's residents claim no religion, and a further 44.7% are undeclared. A 2012 Euro barometer poll on religiosity indicated that 37% of the population was Agnostic or nonbelievers. This count is the highest in the European Union. This refusal to worship in their language resulted to a massive implant of atheist. When the Catholic Church lost power and influence, the Communist rule, reinforced the opposition against the church.

Evangelical Christian Church of Czech Brethren

Protestant Czechs have become almost extinct, as the majority of the people forced to Roman Catholicism left the church and did not affiliate with any religion. Today, the Evangelical churches have a population of around less than 1% (51,916).

Future of Religion in the Czech Republic

The Czech Republic has a rich traditional religious history, but the general citizenry does not seem very interested in any form of organized religion in the 21st Century. The country is the most secular country in the world with censuses and sociological reviews and surveys indicating that most of the people have no religious affiliations. Research show that the higher the education among the people the less they are inclined to religion. There is an apparent lack of interest in Christianity due to the increased popularity of invisible or alternative religion, a belief in magic.

History

Guatemala, officially the Republic of Guatemala, is a country in Central America. It is bordered to the north and west by Mexico, to the northeast by Belize, to the east by Honduras, and to the southeast by El Salvador. It is hydrologically bordered to the south by the Pacific Ocean and to the northeast by the Gulf of Honduras. With an estimated population of around 17.6 million, Guatemala is the most populous country in Central America, the 4th most populous country in North America and the 11th most populous country in the Americas. Its capital and largest city, Guatemala City, is the most populous city in Central America.
